Friday 07/07/2023 - Together for a better future			
The project began with a ceremonial opening, where the mayor of Hegyeshalmi ceremoniously welcomed the delegation of the partner cities. At the beginning of the event, after a joint meeting, the participants got acquainted with the concept of the project and			

learned basic European topics. At the event, citizens were able to learn about one of the basic pillars of European citizenship, the concept of solidarity.

Saturday 08/07/2023 - Let's exchange cultures

We actively involved the participants in the project, thereby motivating the citizens to jointly shape the future of the EU. We have structured the individual programs in such a way that they successively form a coherent whole about the EU itself and its priorities. The activities have been set up to reach all age groups, but they focus on the opinion-forming young generation that guards the future of the EU. Focusing on intercultural dialogue, we tried to create connections and common ground between the cultures, communities and people involved by promoting understanding and interaction. Presenting intercultural dialogue challenges all Europeans to discover the benefits of our rich cultural heritage and learn from different cultural traditions.

09/07/2022 - Sunday - What does the future bring?

In the last part of the day, the participating partners evaluated the productivity and contribution of the project in accordance with the principles and ideas of the project in the framework of the closing dialogue, and at the same time defined their future cooperation. The agreement affects economic and political cooperation and development.

The project fully supported diversity, tolerance and respect for common values, getting to know and introducing cultures, so that in the future the individual nations will also be closer to each other through this.

The aim of the project was to approach the EU from different points of view in order to increase public awareness. Lectures, discussions, workshops and open debates promoted the approach to the EU in both traditional and less traditional ways, strengthened the European integration process based on solidarity, raised awareness and motivated citizens for the upcoming European elections.
